

Heart Word

Introduction: In this lesson, students will practice their spelling skills as they learn about the circulatory system. The lesson is adapted from a lesson idea on the American Heart Association’s website at: <http://www.americanheart.org/presenter.jhtml?identifier=3003220>.

Grade Level and Subject: 3rd Grade Language Arts, Health Education

TEKS: Language Arts – 1A, 1B, 1C, 3C, 5D, 8A, 9B, 14D, 16A, 16B, 16G
Health Education – 4B, 4C

Materials

- “Heart Word Game” Activity Sheet.
- Health text book

Activity:

1. Draw a circle on the board. *What is this shape?* (Circle) *What does “circulate” mean?* (To go around and around like a circle.) *What circulates in our bodies?* (blood)
2. Utilizing a health textbook and allowing students to read aloud about the circulatory system, facilitate a discussion over the circulatory system including how the heart contracts to pump oxygen in the blood to the rest of the body.
3. Include the following words in the students’ weekly spelling list: *blood, circulatory, contracts, heart, vessels, muscle, oxygen, pump, lungs.*
4. Pass out the “Heart Word Game” Activity Sheet. Allow students to work in pairs to complete the activity. Allow several minutes for students to practice spelling the words with their partners.


Evaluation: Evaluate for appropriate participation in the activity. Evaluate students for correct spelling of the words on the weekly spelling test.
